Thank you for purchasing our product. Please read the user manual carefully before using the product for the first time. If you leave the product to a third party, this operating manual must be handed over with it.

1. Safety

- DO NOT allow children to play with or use the product, use is for adults only.
- The pump must not be used under any circumstances when there are people in the pool.
- Strong suction. While the pump is in operation, please keep your hands and hair away from the suction.
- Switch off the filter pump, disconnect it from the power before adjusting, cleaning, removing or performing maintenance work on the pump.
- If the pool is not in use, remove the product.
- Keep the extendable aluminum handle away from above-ground power lines.
- Failure to comply with these safety regulations can result in damage to property, electric shocks, explosions and serious injuries or even death.

These product warnings, instructions, and safety rules cover many, but not all, possible risks and hazards. Please pay attention to your safety when using it.

3. Construction

- 1. Attach the brush to the telescopic handle by pressing the plastic clip. Make sure that the pin clicks correctly into the holes provided.
- 2. Now connect one end of the hose to the opening on the brush. Make sure the hose is

- securely seated. If necessary, use a hose clamp (not included).
- 3. Adjust the desired length of the stem by opening, extending and closing the individual areas by turning.
- 4. Now you can dip the assembled device into the water.
- 5. Fill the hose with water by slowly immersing it in the water to remove the trapped air.
- 6. Once the hose is completely filled with water, it will flow out the other end.
- 7. Now insert the other end of the hose into the opening of the skimmer. Be sure to do this quickly, otherwise the hose will empty again and the pump will draw in air.
- 8. Turn on the pump. To remove air from the hose and pump, turn the bleed valve once or twice to open it, if necessary. For more information, please refer to the pump's owner's manual.
- 9. Caution: Never run the pump without water, as this can cause the filter pump to overheat and thus cause damage. The pool vacuum cleaner must always remain completely submerged in water during use to prevent air from entering the hose. Otherwise, the pump could run dry and be damaged.
- 10. If the suction power decreases, the pump's dirt filter must be cleaned (see cleaning function in the pump's operating instructions). Another possible reason could be a foreign object or dirt in the hose of the floor cleaner.

4. Service

4.1 Before use

- Bleed the hoses and pump before use.
- Keep the brush and hose under water at all times during use.
- Check and empty the dirt filter of your pump during and after each use.

4.2 Operation of the pool floor vacuum cleaner

- 1. The filter pump is an airtight system. To remove trapped air from the hose and pump, turn the vent valve counterclockwise once or twice to open the valve.
- 2. As soon as you notice that water is coming out of the air outlet valve, turn the air outlet valve back on, but not too tightly.
- 3. Connect the pump to the mains and turn on the pump.
- 4. Now you can slowly move over the pool floor with calm movements until the pool floor is freed from all impurities.

Important: If the vacuum cleaner is only vacuuming lightly, check whether there is still air in the hose. If the vacuum cleaner still sucks too weakly, please refer to the operating instructions of your pump again under chapter "Filter pump does not transport water or the flow rate is very low". Also check whether the dirt container and the filter cartridge are clean.

5. Storage

- Make sure the pump is turned off and unplug the cable.
- Disassemble the pool vacuum cleaner by reversing the assembly instructions.
- Clean all accessories thoroughly and allow them to air dry.
- The original packaging can be used as a storage container. Store the product in a cool, dry place.

6. Disposal Notice

6.1 Disposal and packaging

 Please ensure that the packaging is disposed of appropriately in accordance with the guidelines and standards applicable in your region. In some cases, the packaging may consist of plastic bags - take special care to ensure that these do not fall into the hands of children. There is a risk of suffocation!
