

1. Safety Instructions

1.1 Explanation of the symbols



This product **must not** be disposed of with household waste!

By means of a CE marking, it can be recognized that a product complies with the legal requirements of European legal standards and therefore may be traded within the European Community.

1.2 Safety Warnings

If the supply cord is damaged, it must be replaced by the manufacturer, its service agent or a similarly qualified person in order to avoid a hazard.

This appliance is not intended for use by persons (including children) with reduced physical, sensory or mental capabilities or lack of experience and knowledge, unless they have been given supervision or instruction concerning use of the appliance by a person responsible for their safety. Children should be supervised to ensure that they do not play with the appliance.

Substance to be vacuumed - cold ashes from fireplaces, wood/coal stoves, ashtrays, grill.

In the manual the following analogous information has to be given:

"Cold Ash" is ash cooled down for a sufficient time without any pockets of embers inside. This can be confirmed by scouring the ash for pockets of embers by using metal tools before using the ash vacuum cleaner. Cold ash does not emit any recognizable heat.

Empty and clean vacuum cleaner before and after vacuuming to avoid the collection of materials that could pose a fire hazard in the vacuum cleaner.

Do not vacuum any soot or flammable substances.

Always check hoses and vacuum cleaner for heating when vacuuming.

Always empty and clean vacuum cleaner before and after vacuuming.

The battery must be removed from the appliance before it is scrapped;

The appliance must be disconnected from the supply mains when removing the battery; The battery is to be disposed of safely.

WARNING: Read all safety warnings and all instructions.

Failure to follow the warnings and instructions listed below may result in electric shock, fire and/or serious injury.

WARNING: Some household dust contains chemicals known to the State of California to cause cancer, birth defects or other reproductive harm such as asbestos and lead in lead-based paint. **WARNING**: To reduce the risk of fire, electrical shock or injury:

- Do not use without dust bag and/or filters in place.
- Do not charge the unit outdoors.
- Shock Hazard. To protect against risk of electrical shock, do not put unit or charging base in water or other liquid.
- Do not use dry hand vacs to pick up liquids, toxic substances, flammable or combustible liquids such as gasoline or use in areas where they may be present.
- Do not use wet/dry hand vacs to pick up toxic substances, flammable or combustible liquids such as gasoline or use in areas where they may be present.
- Do not operate in the presence of explosives and/or flammable fumes or liquids.
- Shock Hazard. Do not operate any appliance with a damaged cord or charger or after the appliance malfunctions, is left outdoors, dropped into water or is damaged in any manner. Return the appliance to any authorized service facility.
- Do not use dry hand vacs outdoors or on wet surfaces.
- Do not abuse the cord. Never carry the charger or base by the cord or yank to disconnect from an outlet; instead grasp the charger and pull to disconnect. Keep cord away from heated surfaces. Do not pull cord around sharp edges or corners.
- Do not allow the cord to hang over the edge of a table or counter or touch hot surfaces. The unit should be placed or mounted away from sinks and hot surfaces.
- Do not use an extension cord. Plug the charger directly into an electrical outlet.
- Use the charger only in a standard electrical outlet (100-240V/50-60Hz).
- Do not attempt to use the charger with any other product; do not attempt to charge this product with any other charger. Use only the charger supplied by the manufacturer to recharge.
- Do not attempt to use the battery pack with any other product;

- Keep hair, loose clothing, and all parts of body away from openings and moving parts.
- Do not insert accessories when unit is running.
- Shock Hazard. Do not handle plug or appliance with wet hands.
- Do not put any object into unit openings. Do not use with any openings blocked; keep free of dust, lint, hair, and anything that may reduce air flow.
- Fire Hazard. Do not vacuum burning or smoking materials, such as lit cigarette butts, matches or hot aches.
- Do not use on or near hot surfaces.
- Use extra caution when cleaning on stairs.
- This appliance is intended for household use only and not for commercial or industrial use.
- Use only as described in this manual. Use only manufacturer's recommended attachments.
- Unplug the charger from outlet before any routine cleaning or maintenance.
- This product includes rechargeable Lithium lon batteries. Do not incinerate batteries as they will explode at high temperatures.
- If battery contents come into contact with the skin immediately wash area with mild soap and water. If battery liquid gets into the eye, rinse water over the open eye for 15 minutes or until irritation ceases. If medical attention is needed, the battery electrolyte for Lithium lon batteries is composed of a mixture of liquid organic carbonates and lithium salts.

WARNING: Do not look into the air vents when the unit is switched on, as sometimes there is a possibility of small debris being discharged from the air vents, especially after cleaning/replacement of the filters as debris inside the unit can be disturbed.

• The charger supplied with this product is intended to be plugged in such that it is correctly orientated in a vertical or floor mount position.

2. Area of Application

- Substance to be vacuumed cold ashes from fireplaces, wood/coal stoves, ashtrays, grill.
- Empty and clean vacuum cleaner before and after vacuuming to avoid the collection of materials that could pose a fire hazard in the vacuum cleaner.

3. Restriction of Use

- Do not use for the separation of health-hazardous dusts (dust classes L, M, H).
- Do not vacuum soot.
- Vacuum only ashes from admissible fuels.
- Do not vacuum any hot, burning or glowing objects.
- Do not vacuum any objects that are hotter than > 40 °C.
- Do not vacuum any flammable substances.

4. Battery Safety Warnings

4.1 Battery

- Do not disassemble or open, drop (mechanical abuse), crush, bend or deform, puncture, or shred.
- Do not modify or remanufacture, attempt to insert foreign objects into the battery, immerse or expose to water or other liquids, or expose to fire, excessive heat including soldering irons, or put in microwave oven.
- Only use the battery/tool with a charging system specified by the manufacturer/supplier.
- Do not short-circuit a battery or allow metallic or conductive objects to contact both battery terminals simultaneously.
- Dispose of used batteries promptly according to the manufacturer/supplier's instructions.
- Improper battery use may result in a fire, explosion, or other hazard.
- Battery/tool usage by children should be supervised.

4.2 Charging


- This manual contains important safety and operating instructions.
- Before using battery charger, read all instructions and cautionary warnings on battery charger and product using battery. CAUTION: To reduce the risk of injury, use this charger only with this product. Batteries in other products may burst causing personal injury or damage.
- Do not expose charger to rain or snow.
- Use of an attachment not recommended or sold by KAITELY may result in a risk of fire, electric shock, or injury to persons.
- To reduce risk of damage to electric plug and cord, pull by plug rather than cord when disconnecting charger.
- Make sure cord is located so that it will not be stepped on, tripped over, or otherwise subjected to damage or stress.
- An extension cord should not be used unless absolutely necessary. Use of improper extension cord could result in a risk of fire, electric shock or electrocution.
- Use only the supplied charger when charging your tool. The use of any other charger could damage the tool or create a hazardous condition.
- Use only one charger when charging.
- Do not attempt to open the charger. There are no customer serviceable parts inside.
- Do not incinerate the tool or batteries even if they are severely damaged or completely worn out. The batteries can explode in a fire. Toxic fumes and materials are created when lithium

ion battery packs are burned.

- Do not charge or use battery in explosive atmospheres, such as in the presence of flammable liquids, gases or dust. Inserting or removing the battery from the charger may ignite the dust or fumes.

	Assemble the Ash vacuum cleaner.	
	Assemble the hose. (The notch is aimed at the triangle.)	
•	Assemble the Aluminium nozzle.	
4	Install the battery pack.	
	Switch on (Press the switch button).	
	Return the product to the charger immediately after use so that it will be ready and fully charged for the next use. Ensure that the product is fully engaged with the charger.

Clean the filter by shaking off the ash.
Assemble the ash vacuum cleaner.

8. Error Detection

Before you contact our service center, please check the following:

Problem	Possible reason	Advice
Motor does not start	-The battery pack is not installed.	- Install the battery pack.
	 The battery pack has been damaged. The battery pack has no power. 	 Replace the qualified battery pack. Charge the battery pack.
	- Cleaner not switched on.	-Switch on the appliance
Suction power is weaker	-Unit clogged. -Dust filter needs cleaning. -Dust container not in position.	 -Remove the blockage. -Clean the dust filter. -Attach the dust container again to the cleaner.
